Dear “D3” Participant:

As part of the RCDGSDC’s environmental compliance requirements, we have enlisted the services of an Archeology Consultant to perform detailed property surveys of the private parcels which are participating in our “D3” Tree Removal Program.

The consultant and their field staff will be working in the Descanso area over the next several weeks and will be required to enter your property to evaluate for Cultural Resources that may exist. They will use flagging to establish areas that are not to be disturbed by contractors when tree removal is taking place on your property.

The Right of Entry Agreement you previously signed to participate in our program allows the Archeology staff to enter your property to perform this required work. The consultant has been provided with contact information for all participants in the “D3” Program and will be contacting residents when specific arrangements are required to access a property.
